SUBJECT: Factors to Estimate February 2018 Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Student Membership

for the 2017-18 Third Florida Education Finance Program (FEFP) Calculation

Attached is a list of the factors that will be used to estimate each school district's February 2018 FTE student membership for the 2017-18 third FEFP calculation. Ten factors were calculated for each district, one for each of the FEFP programs.

The February 2018 factors are derived using previous changes between October and February FTE. To estimate the February 2018 survey FTE for the 2017-18 third FEFP calculation, the calculated factors will be multiplied by the prorated October 2017 survey FTE.

The FTE that will be used in the 2017-18 third FEFP calculation is the sum of the calculated July and October 2017 FTE, the estimated February 2018 FTE that is derived from the February factors process and the estimated June 2018 FTE.

Please review the recommended factors on the attached worksheet, then complete and email the worksheet to the Office of Funding and Financial Reporting at <u>BSBS DistrictForecasting@fldoe.org</u> by Friday, October 27, 2017. If these factors are not appropriate for determining the February FTE, please propose revisions on the attached form. The review of these factors is critical because the estimated February FTE will be a major determinant in the amount of each district's FEFP funding following the 2017-18 third FEFP calculation. The attached factors will be used if no response is received by the deadline.
