Approach: While creating this curriculum, the authors viewed the term career to include all aspects of the social, psychological, environmental, economic and technical factors that influence a person's life including their occupation. Career education is a developmental process that parallels human development. Relevant growth and development patterns of high school students are the basis for the organization of information and activities presented in the text. The broad sequence of information and activities offered in this book enable the instructor to provide for the needs of students who are above and below the norm in their career development as well as those who are on-target. Each chapter in the book blends into a developmental framework for making career choices. Three major components are self-awareness, decision making and career information.

Self-Awareness: Unit 1 of the textbook guides your students through an adventure of self-discovery. The understanding of self is a prerequisite for mature career exploration. The recurring theme of self-awareness is reinforced throughout the text. The book provides numerous activities to help each student become aware of their personal interests, aptitudes, abilities, feelings, attitudes and values. Chapter 1 begins by helping each student to be aware of the characteristics of their present stage of life and establishes skills to master to become a mature young adult. Erik Erikson's Eight States of Man and Eli Ginzberg's Theory of Vocational Choice are the basis for much of the information and activities in chapter 1. Erikson defines skills that each person must master in order to progress to the next developmental stage of life. The activities in the book and ancillaries are designed to facilitate the users career development (maturity) and help them progress to the next state of their career (life).

Making Informed Decisions: The case studies as well as an entire chapter is devoted to learning and using decision making skills. The decision making style, rational decision-making process and seven personal orientations described are based on many years of career counseling, facilitating career workshops and participation in seminars and courses taught by John Crites, John Holland, Mark Savickas, Donald Super, Gail Sheeny and others.

Career Information: Occupational information is one of the most important types of information needed to make an informed career choice. Many other types of career information are also critical to this process, which this text takes into account. Unit 1 covers having accurate self-information and the ability to relate personal characteristics to specific occupations. Chapter 6 instructs students to be aware of the education and training requirements for specific occupations and the availability of education and training. Chapter 7 shows the importance of having the necessary communication skills (reading, speaking, listening, etc) to obtain and information effectively.
