**** Formal project award notices (DOE200 Forms) are issued upon completion of the internal application technical review process. Award projection information has been posted to assist district personnel with internal planning work.** Official project award notices are forwarded directly to district superintendents following formal signature approval. The formal award notification process will be completed as expeditiously as possible to facilitate implementation of new projects. **In certain instances, proposals have been recommended for funding at levels different from the original requests. In such instances, successful budget negotiations will be required in order to address program priorities and expectations.** Bureau of Instruction and Innovation staff are looking forward to implementation of 2007-08 and 2008-09 competitive EETT projects. All of the funded projects will involve teacher participation in formal Teaching and Learning Institutes.

The 2007-08 EETT proposal competition involved thirty-eight (38) applications and a total funding request of \$28,353,833.65. Fifteen (15) projects have been recommended for funding. The amount of funds available to support projects turned out to be higher than anticipated (due to availability of internal program transfer dollars and the allocation of **projected** 2008-09 competitive funds). A formal proposal evaluation process was used to select proposals which seemed to have the greatest chance of success. The proposal scoring process was based on review criteria prescribed in the 2007-08 EETT Competitive Application/RFP. The review process involved 20 educators who contributed their expertise in instructional technology, technology integration, project design/implementation, and curriculum. For districts that did not compete this year or that are not slated to receive funding, it is our hope that a future EETT proposal competition can provide opportunities to meet critical local technology resource and/or training needs.

Information provided in this chart is preliminary planning data only and does not represent a funding commitment by the Florida Department of Education. Failure to address one or more NCLB:EETT program participation requirements, application documentation deficiencies, unsuccessful proposal budget negotiations, or lack of an acceptable district technology plan can delay (or prevent) issuance of an official EETT project award notification. Continued participation in the NCLB:EETT program requires that districts make a concerted effort to meet their obligations as outlined in EETT project applications, on DOE200 Project Award Notices, and within the Federal NCLB:EETT legislation.

Competitive proposal review materials (scores & comments) will be provided to all applicants as soon as practical. It is expected that proposal evaluation feedback can be disseminated by April 30, 2008. It will not be necessary for district personnel to submit a special request to receive proposal review feedback. This information will be forwarded to the official application contact (identified on the DOE100A EETT application cover sheet). Review feedback will normally be sent by e-mail (if a working e-mail address is available) otherwise the material will be faxed or sent through regular mail.
