Yes – This identifies each cohort group to whom the requirement applies.

Either – This indicates that these two cohorts can use either FCAT-1 (retakes) or FCAT-2 (Grade 10) scores for graduation.

¹ Notice of concordant score changes provided in the fall of the junior year. Students then have two years to retake FCAT or attain concordant scores. The 2010-11 senior class would be the first cohort of seniors to use the FCAT-1 2009 ACT/SAT Concordant Scores if changes are made.

² Concordant scores between FCAT-1 and FCAT-2 will be needed before FCAT-2 passing scores are established.

³ FCAT-2 Retakes will begin in the fall of 2012. Seniors in 2012-13 and 2013-14 may use either passing standard (FCAT-1 or FCAT-2) to meet their graduation requirement. The 2014-15 senior class will be cohort of seniors to use the FCAT-2 and ACT/SAT Concordant Scores.
