General Information (Mary Jo Butler)

One Credit Course offered as One-Half Credit Course

Any elective course listed in the grades 9-12 section of the Course Code Directory as earning one credit may also be offered for one-half credit. The school must select the appropriate course

requirements from the Course Description (<http://www.firn.edu/doe/curriculum/crscode/basic612/basic912.htm>) to be mastered in the one-half credit course. For example, students may meet the high school graduation requirements for performing fine arts and practical arts by taking one full credit in performing fine arts **or** one full credit in practical arts **or** one-half credit in performing fine arts **and** one-half credit in practical arts. In order to manage the number of different courses in the Course code Directory, most fine arts courses have been developed for one credit. A district or school may choose to offer one or more of these courses as a one-semester course. The transcript should reflect the Course Code Directory course number, title, and the appropriate credit, in this case one-half credit instead of one credit.

Foreign Language (Lisa Saavedra)

Pursuant to Sections 1007.261(9) and 1007.2615, Florida Statue, students may elect to take two consecutive courses in American Sign Language (ASL I and II) to meet the foreign language requirements of one of the three-year graduation programs and for admission to Florida's state universities. Beginning in the 2005-06 school year, American Sign Language courses will fall under the Foreign Language Subject Area in the Course Code Directory.

Section 1: Course Number System (Cathy Bishop/Shan Goff) **Prekindergarten Basic Definitions:**

Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program – Beginning with the 2005-06 school, the voluntary prekindergarten education program for children attaining the age of four on, or before, September 1st, will be implemented as provided by Sections 1(b) and (c), Article IX of the State Constitution. School districts **meeting specific requirements in law** are permitted to implement a school-year program. School districts **will be required** to provide a summer prekindergarten program beginning in the summer of 2006. The credential requirements for staff differ between the school-year and summer prekindergarten program. Qualifications for staff are listed in the data section of the Course Code Directory. The CDA or CDA equivalency credential is acceptable for the school-year program as long as Title I funds are not supporting the program and the voluntary prekindergarten education program is not part of the Title I school-wide program plan for the school.

Delete: *These programs, when previously supported through funds made directly available to school districts, were identified as Prekindergarten Early Intervention Programs, Florida First Start, or District Operated Subsidized Child Care programs.*

Prekindergarten Exceptional:

- When ESE classes for prekindergarten children with disabilities include children served in Head Start Title I, school readiness, or the voluntary prekindergarten education program using a “reverse mainstreaming model, the teacher must hold certification as listed in the Exceptional Education Table – Required Certification.

- When the Head Start, Title I, school readiness, or voluntary prekindergarten education program serves as an inclusive setting for a child with a disability, the teacher may hold certification as required by the Head Start, Title I, school readiness, voluntary prekindergarten education, or as listed in the Exceptional Education Table – Required Certification.
- [Beginning July 1, 2011, the prekindergarten disabilities endorsement will be required for the following certification areas identified for course numbers 7650030 and 7650130: any exceptional education field, early childhood education, and primary education.]

Reading

K-6 or 1-6 will remain the appropriate coverage to teach reading at the elementary or middle school (6th grade only) level. In order to teach a reading course at the middle school (with the exception of a 6th grade elementary education certified teacher teaching 6th grade reading to sixth graders) or high school level subsequent to June 30, 2006, a teacher must be certified in reading or carry the reading endorsement on the certificate. The reading endorsement may only be added to a certificate that reflects a Bachelor's degree or higher.

Certification in Primary Education K-3 and Prekindergarten Primary K-3 are also appropriate coverages at those grade levels.
