GRADE 11 SCIENCE

DISTRICTS may administer Grade 11 Science on Day 1, Day 2, Day 3, Day 4, or Day 5. This must be a DISTRICT (not a school-by-school) decision. Both 75-minute sessions must be administered on the same day. Each district must notify the FDOE of the selected Grade 11 Science administration day.

RETAKES

Students in Grades 10-Adult participating in the RETAKE tests may be allowed to work until the end of the school day to complete the Retake test administered that day. **DISTRICTS** may choose any two days during the testing period to administer the RETAKE tests. All sites in each district must administer the RETAKE tests on the same days, as specified by the district.

Make-up testing may begin on Day 2 and continue through Day 8 as needed.

There should be no deviation from the established FCAT administration schedule unless districts requested and received written approval from the FDOE prior to implementation.
