- ◉ Where does the student belong?
- ◉ Which test is the valid test?

Multiple Information Sources

- ◉ Preidentification (**PreID**) information from data file upload
- ◉ Gridded information from student **test books**
- ◉ Gridded information from document count forms (**DCF**)
- ◉ New student **wizard** information from PearsonAccess

Which test is the Valid Test?

- ◎ **Score Status of 6 = Duplicate record**
 - > If the same student takes the same test more than once.
- ◎ **Students testing in two or more of the following caused delays:**
 - Grade 10 Reading (Math) – paper
 - Grade 10 Reading (Math) – online
 - Retake Reading (Math) – paper
 - Retake Reading (Math) – online


Which Test is the Valid Test?

- ◉ We resolve as many duplicate tests as possible within the short time we have to validate test scores; however, duplicate records that take longer to resolve will appear in wave 1 of late reporting.

What is the Student's Grade Level?

- ◉ New ways to avoid being flagged as an off-grade tester:
 - > Online tests: “**Tested Grade**” linked to a student's online test assignment in PearsonAccess will be available for updates
 - > Paper tests: New PreID upload process (starting with Spring 2012 RMS administration)

What is the Student's Grade Level?

○ New PreID upload Process

> **Partial PreID files will be accepted**

Example - If 50 students are waiting for a grade promotion and 450 know their grade level:

- Option 1: Upload a partial file with the 450 students whose grade level is known. Then, before the end of PreID window 1, upload a second partial file with the 50 remaining students after confirming grade level. This second partial file will NOT delete existing student records (total records in PearsonAccess = 500).
- Option 2: Upload all 500 student records. Then, before the end of PreID window 1, if the grade level changes for these 50 students, upload those 50 students in a second partial file using the new grade levels. The second partial file will NOT delete existing records. Instead, the new file will match to the previous 50 records and update their grade level (total records in PearsonAccess = 500)

What is the Student's Grade Level?

◎ New PreID upload Process:

- › **More than one PreID window for the same administration**

Example - If 50 students are waiting for a grade promotion and 450 know their grade level:

- If grade level for 50 students is still unknown by close of PreID window 1, re-upload 50 students with new grade level during PreID window 2. This partial file will match to the previous 50 records and update their grade level. Caveat = Labels generated from PreID window 1 will display old grade levels even though student will have an updated grade on PearsonAccess (new labels will not be generated for changes made to grade level and other demographic information during Window 2).

Additional Cleanup: Winter 2011-12 EOC Algebra 1

Student information box (bubble all that apply)

- Student is taking Algebra 1 EOC Assessment for the first time
- Student has previously taken the Algebra 1 EOC Assessment
