Initial Sound Fluency determines a child's ability to recognize the beginning sound(s) in an orally presented word. Children are shown pictures of objects and asked to identify the picture that begins with the sound the examiner presents. Children are also asked to produce the beginning sound for an orally presented word that matches one of the pictures.
