Approach: The educational approach of Developing Career and Living Skills is based on several assumptions:

1. Students are more receptive to learning when the material is relevant and they can be actively involved with it. Therefore, the textbook uses scenarios, case studies, role-playing and projects in which students learn through experiences.
2. Students learn better when they can acquire information through images as well as words. In this textbook, information is integrated about career interest areas into each chapter through illustrations, sidebars, and graphs.
3. Students retain more when they use critical thinking skills as they learn. Therefore, the writing in the textbook and every illustration caption poses questions that entice the students to think about what they are learning.
4. Students must be "global" in their mind set and, to accomplish that, every chapter has material on the diversity of our world today.
5. Students must accept technology as an integral part of their lives. This text weaves technology into activities seamlessly, not as sidebar material.
6. Students learn by being exposed to new material at a variety of levels. Hence, each section of text is followed by review questions, critical thinking questions, and then enrichment activities.
