BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Rule 6D-3.008, FAC., Discrimination Complaint Procedures for Student Access, indicates procedures to be followed by individuals wishing to file complaints regarding issues related to race, sex, national origin, or disability. It is being amended to bring language up to currently used terminology and to be consistent with state and federal mandates.

This rule has been approved and adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind, consistent with authority given to them in Section 1002.36 (4)(c), F.S., at a meeting on November 7, 2003. The rule has been properly noticed in the Florida Administrative Weekly, and a public hearing was held on Friday, November 7, 2003. It is duly submitted for approval by the State Board of Education.
