BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Rule 6E-1.0032, F.A.C. Fair Consumer Practices establishes the requirements for institutions for refund policies.

The amendment is to change the drop add period from two weeks to one week. The change is to make the rule consistent with the drop add period that the majority of the institutions have presently. The rule has been approved by the Commission for Independent Education at a public hearing held on May 16, 2003 and a public hearing held on November 13, 2003, following a rules committee meeting that took public comment on May 15, 2003. The rule has been properly noticed in the Florida Administrative Weekly.
