Approve amended Rule 6D-3.0021 Individual Educational Plan

AUTHORITY FOR STATE BOARD ACTION

Section 1002.36(4)(c) F.S.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Rule 6D-3.0021, FAC., establishes guidelines, procedures and timelines to be followed in the development/revision of the Individual Educational Plan (IEP) of a student. The rule is being amended to be in concert with the 1999 amendments to the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) and SBE Rule 6A-6.03028, FAC as amended.

Language no longer applicable such as (1)(c)4 'residential determination made by the school district...' is deleted. Florida statute 1002.20(6)(a) allows for parental choice.

Subsection (1)(c)(2) is being amended to reflect the IDEA changes on the list of participants, placing parents at the top of the list. The Bureau of Instructional Support and Community Services of the Department of Education recommended the language relating to the regular education teacher which is incorporated in this section.

This rule has been approved and adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind, consistent with authority given to them in Section 1002.36 (4)(c) F.S., at a meeting on December 13, 2003. The rule has been properly noticed in the Florida Administrative Weekly, and a public hearing was held on Saturday, December 13, 2003. It is duly submitted for approval by the State Board of Education. This rule applies to the students enrolled in the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind.
