Approve amended Rule 6D-3.007 Provisions of Non-Academic and Extracurricular Services and Activities

AUTHORITY FOR STATE BOARD ACTION

Section 1002.36(4)(c) F.S.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Rule 6D-3.007 assures that provisions of non-academic extracurricular activities are made available to students in the Least Restrictive environment. The amendment removes the word 'eligible' for the wording of the rule as all non-academic and extracurricular services and activities are available to all students who are able to participate.

This rule has been approved and adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind, consistent with authority given to them in Section 1002.36 (4)(c) F.S., at a meeting on December 13, 2003. The rule has been properly noticed in the Florida Administrative Weekly, and a public hearing was held on Saturday, December 13, 2003. It is duly submitted for approval by the State Board of Education. This rule applies to the students at the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind.

The Bureau of Instructional Support and Community Services concurred with this amendment, no input received.
