It is duly submitted for final approval by the State Board of Education, as required by Section 1005.22 (1)(e)1, Florida Statutes.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

Rule 6E-1.0032, F.A.C. Fair Consumer Practices establishes the requirements for institutions.

The amendment deletes the language regarding antihazing policies for licensed colleges and universities in the rule because the language is identical to the statute. Rules are not promulgated to repeat statutory language but serve as clarification. The rule was considered and approved by the Commission for Independent Education at a public hearing held on September 12, 2003, following a rules committee meeting on September 11, 2003. The rule has been properly noticed in the Florida Administrative Weekly.
