AUTHORITY FOR STATE BOARD ACTION

It is duly submitted for final approval by the State Board of Education, as required by Section 1005.22 (1)(e)1, Florida Statutes.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Rule 6E-2.001, F.A.C. Approved Applicant Status establishes the process and the requirements for receipt of an approved applicant status.

The amendment deletes the language relating to presentation of the approved applicant status application at the next Commission meeting. The change is necessary because the Commission has delegated the authority to the Executive Director to approve the approved applicant status. The Commission does not consider such applications. The rule was considered and approved by the Commission for Independent Education at a public hearing held on September 12, 2003, following a rules committee meeting on September 11, 2003. The rule has been properly noticed in the Florida Administrative Weekly.
