**SUBJECT:** Appleton Museum Resolution

### **PROPOSED BOARD ACTION**

Motion: Authorize the Commissioner of Education to communicate to the Legislature the State Board's intent that the funds for the Appleton Museum be transferred in the 2004-05 budget from the University System Education and General Budget to the Community College Budget.

### **AUTHORITY FOR STATE BOARD ACTION**

Section 1001.02(2)(e), F.S. – State Board to Adopt K-20 Budget; Section 1011.01, F.S. – K-20 Budget System Established; Section 1001.64(11), F.S. – Community College Budget Request; and Section 1011.40(1), F.S. – University Budgets and Section 216.023(11), Florida Statutes.

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The Appleton Museum of Art in Ocala, Florida is one of the South's premier art repositories and education centers. Originally built to display and preserve the collection of Arthur I. Appleton, the museum has expanded to include traveling exhibitions, educational programs, and cultural events. The museum opened to the public in December 1987. Since July 1, 1990, the Appleton Museum of Art has been jointly owned by Florida State University Foundation and Central Florida Community College (CFCC) Foundation. This amendment would assign the funding and management for the museum to CFCC.
