PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Approve proposed changes to Rule 6A-22.006, Florida Administrative Code.

AUTHORITY FOR STATE BOARD ACTION

Section 440.491 (5), (6), (8), Florida Statutes.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Rule 6A-22.006, Florida Administrative Code implements the Department's responsibility to conduct Screenings of workers to determine their eligibility for training and education benefits under Section 440.491, Florida Statutes of the Florida Worker's Compensation Law. The proposed change adds a requirement that injured workers provide documentation to establish identity and employment eligibility. Pursuant to this rule, acceptable documentation shall be consistent with the United States Department of Justice, Immigration and Naturalization Service's Employment Eligibility Verification Form I-9.
