BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Rule 6A-6.03020, FAC, Specially Designed Instruction for Students Who Are Homebound or Hospitalized, was revised to clarify eligibility, medical and psychiatric conditions, and settings and instructional modes for students who are homebound or hospitalized. The rule requires an annual medical statement that includes the duration of the condition or the prognosis and recommendation for re-entry into school.

The rule was the subject of statewide rule development workshops in January 2000, March 2000, October/November 2001 and October 2003 to solicit public comment. The rule was properly noticed in the Florida Administrative Weekly most recently on February 13, 2004.
