BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Rule 6A-6.03028, FAC, Development of Individual Educational Plans for Students with Disabilities, was revised to incorporate the requirements of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) regarding the role of parents, components of the individual educational plan (IEP), and the participants of the IEP team. The rule includes a subsection with an extensive list of definitions of common terms.

The rule was the subject of statewide rule development workshops in October/November 2001 and October 2003 to solicit public comment. The rule was properly noticed in the Florida Administrative Weekly on February 13, 2004.
