**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

Rule 6A-6.03313, FAC, Procedural Safeguards for Exceptional Students Who Are Gifted, was developed to identify the procedural safeguards currently afforded to students who are gifted including prior notice, content of the notice, parental consent, examination of records and evaluations at private expense. The rule also clarifies complaint procedures, due process hearings procedures, and the procedures for appeal.

The rule was the subject of statewide rule development workshops in January 2000, March 2000, October/November 2001, and October 2003 to solicit public comment. The rule was properly noticed in the Florida Administrative Weekly.
