**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

Rule 6A-6.0331, FAC, Identification and Determination of Eligibility of Exceptional Students for Specially Designed Instruction, was revised to incorporate the state's goal to provide a full educational opportunity to all students with disabilities and to address activities required prior to the referral of any student for exceptional student education. The rule makes general education interventions consistent across all program areas and specifies a timeline for evaluation of students suspected of having a disability.

The rule was the subject of statewide rule development workshops in January 2000, March 2000, October/November 2001, and October 2003 to solicit public comment. The rule was properly noticed in the Florida Administrative Weekly most recently on February 13, 2004.
