BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Rule 6E-2.004, F.A.C. Standards and Procedures for Licensure sets forth the required information and documentation for submission with an institution's application for a license or for a new level of licensure.

The amendment deletes repetitive language in the student catalog that describes the institution's policy regarding satisfactory academic progress. The amendment of the rule has been approved by the Commission of Independent Education at the meeting held on January 23, 2004, following a rules committee meeting January 21, 2004. The rule has been properly noticed in the Florida Administrative Weekly.
