6A-14.0341 Responsibilities of Community Colleges for Vocational Education.

(1) Each community college with a department designated as an area vocational education school by the State Board of Education has primary responsibility for vocational instruction specified in Rule 6A-14.030(3) and (4), FAC, for persons age nineteen (19) or older within the limits of the designation.

(2) All community colleges are responsible for vocational instruction specified in Rule 6A-14.030(2) and (4), FAC, within their districts.

(3) Community colleges with departments designated as area vocational education schools, upon request of school boards in their districts, may provide vocational instruction specified in Rule 6A-14.030(3), FAC, for persons under age nineteen (19), including students in grades ten (10) through twelve (12). In such case, the board of trustees shall file with the Commissioner its plan for providing such instruction.

(4) A board of trustees may enter into an agreement with a public school board for either to use the facilities of the other, or with a public school board or another board of trustees to provide instructional services.
