BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Rule 6E-2.0061, F.A.C., Actions Against a Licensee; Penalties sets forth the deviations from the required penalties that the Commission for Independent Education is required to assess for cases.

The amendment allows for the consideration of aggravating or mitigating factors present in an individual case when assessing penalties. The amendment of the rule has been approved by the Commission of Independent Education at the meeting held on January 23, 2004, following a rules committee meeting January 22, 2004.
