### **AUTHORITY FOR STATE BOARD ACTION**

Section 1005.22(1)(e)1., Florida Statutes.

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

Rule 6E-4.001, FAC., Fees and Expenses sets forth the required base, workload, fines and disciplinary oversight, licensure application, and program fees and expenses.

Currently, numerous applications for extensions are being processed which require staff resources and extensive review. The present rule does not mandate a set fee for extensions. This amendment establishes a a \$500 fee for a first time provisional or annual licensure extension; a \$750 fee for a second time provisional or annual licensure extension; and a \$1,500 fee for a third time provisional or annual licensure extension. The rule is further amended to clarify that licensure application fees, base fees, and program fees are to be paid annually. The final amendment to the rule is to require a ten dollar charge for the student transcript search which will include a copy of the transcript if found. The amendments to the rule have been approved by the Commission of Independent Education at the meeting held on January 23, 2004, following a rules committee meeting January 22, 2004.
