Sections 1001.02(1)(9), 1001.03, 1001.64, 1010.01, 1010.02, 1001.64, 1001.65, 1012.83, Florida Statutes.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The purpose of the amendments is to ensure consistency with the governing Florida Statutes. The amendments also reflect the abolishment of the State Board of Community Colleges and the establishment of the State Board of Education as the governing entity. The purpose is consistency in law and rule. The purpose of the repealed rules are due to the elimination of the State Board of Community Colleges, changes in governance and subsequent transfers of powers and duties to the State Board of Education. The repealed rules are to reflect changes made in the Florida Statutes.
