**SUBJECT:** Seminole Community College - Request Approval to change Site Designation from Center to Campus for Oviedo in Southeast Seminole County.

---

### **PROPOSED BOARD ACTION**

To approve the request from the Board of Trustees of Seminole Community College to change the Center site designation in Oviedo to the Oviedo Campus.

### **AUTHORITY FOR STATE BOARD ACTION**

Section 1001.02 (7) (e), Florida Statutes.

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

Rule 6A-14.0061, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), entitled "Campus, Center, Special Purpose Center and Instructional Site Designations" provides that the State Board of Education (successor to the State Board of Community Colleges) review and recommend for or against the establishment of campuses, centers and special purpose centers. Based on the documentation presented by the college in their request for the new designation of a campus, the criteria stipulated in Rule 6H-1.040 are satisfied. The Oviedo site has shown extensive growth in the last five years in FTE's. The college is requesting campus designations to allow additional plant survey recommendation for the site, especially in Library and the Library Services area. The primary threshold in Rule 6A-14.0061(1) and (4)(e) F.A.C. is 1000 FTE's. The Oviedo site has met this requirement, and therefore, this request is justified.
