**SUBJECT:** Daytona Beach Community College - Request Site Designation Approval for a Special Purpose Center for Southwest Volusia County

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### **PROPOSED BOARD ACTION**

To approve the request from the Board of Trustees of Daytona Beach Community College for a Special Purpose Center site designation located in Southwest Volusia.

### **AUTHORITY FOR STATE BOARD ACTION**

Section 1001.02 (7) (e), Florida Statutes.

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

Rule 6A-14.0061, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.) entitled "Campus, Center, Special Purpose Center and Instructional Site Designations" provides that the State Board of Education (successor to the State Board of Community Colleges) review and recommend for or against the establishment of campuses, centers and special purpose centers. Based on the documentation presented by the college for the new site, all the criteria stipulated in Rule 6A-14.0061, F.A.C., are satisfied. The college is planning a Corporate Training Center in partnership with three cities, the County and the West Volusia Chamber of Commerce. The county is going to donate the land for the Center and Daytona Beach Community College expects all of the other partners to donate the funds to build the facility with Matching Funds.
