

HURRICANE RELATED LEGISLATIVE ISSUES

RESERVE FOR CASH FLOW ASSISTANCE

Establish a special fund for districts that have cash flow problems. This fund would be administered by the Department of Education with strict guidelines and documentation for advancement and repayment.

LOSS OF STUDENT ENROLLMENT

Funds would be provided to districts, community colleges and universities for revenue losses for displaced students as a direct result of the hurricanes.

- A. K-12—Loss of student enrollment funding.
- B. Community colleges and workforce education—loss of tuition and fees.
- C. Universities—loss of tuition and fees.

GAIN OF STUDENT ENROLLMENT IN CAPPED PROGRAMS

Adjust district's funding for special programs with capped enrollment if it is determined to be a direct result of the hurricanes.

FACILITIES DAMAGES

Assistance with the 10% not covered by insurance or FEMA.

ADDITIONAL OPERATING COST

Assistance for the operating losses at our education institutions that do not qualify for insurance or FEMA reimbursement.
