6A-4.02431 Specialization Requirements for the American Sign Language

Endorsement -- Academic Class.

- (1) A bachelor-s or higher degree with certification in an academic class coverage, and
- (2) Eighteen (18) semester hours in American Sign Language to include three
- (3) semester hours in each area specified below:
 - (a) First and second language acquisition,
 - (b) Linguistics of American Sign Language,
 - (c) Aspects of the deaf culture and community,
 - (d) Methods of teaching American Sign Language,
 - (e) American Sign Language IV, and
 - (f) American Sign Language literature, or
- (3) A bachelor-s or higher degree with certification in an academic class coverage, and a valid Professional Level Certificate issued by the American Sign Language Teachers Association (ASLTA).
