BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Rule 6E-3.002, F.A.C., Administration of the Board, provides for the administration of the State Board of Independent Colleges and Universities, an entity which no longer exists. The State Board of Independent Colleges and Universities was merged with the State Board of Non-Public Career Education creating the Commission for Independent Education in 2002. Prior to the development of new rules, the Commission was administered by Chapter 6E-3, FAC—Administration of Board. Rules of the Commission for Independent Education are contained in Chapter 6E-1, 6E-2, and 6E-4 of the Florida Administrative Code. The repeal of this rule will eliminate from the Code a rule which is no longer relevant or for which there is no longer statutory authority.
