SUBJECT: 2004-05 State Board of Education Strategic Plan

PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Approve 2004-05 State Board of Education Strategic Plan.

AUTHORITY FOR STATE BOARD ACTION

Sections 1001.02, 1001.10, and 1008.31, Florida Statutes

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Section 1008.31(3), F.S. establishes the mission of Florida's K-20 education system as: "to increase the proficiency of all students within one seamless, efficient system, their knowledge and skills through learning opportunities and research valued by students, parents, and communities."

Law requires the State Board of Education to establish and maintain an accountability system that measures student progress toward the following goals:

1. Highest Student Achievement
2. Seamless Articulation and Maximum Access
3. Skilled Workforce and Economic Development
4. Quality Efficient Services

Section 1001.02, F.S., provides that the State Board of education develop systemwide education goals and policies, including sector and K-20 system strategic plans.

Section 1001.10, F.S. specifies that Commissioner of Education, as the chief educational officer of the state, is responsible for giving full assistance to the State Board of Education in enforcing compliance with the mission and goals of the seamless K-20 education system.

A presentation of a revised 2004-05 Strategic Plan – including updated objectives and performance measures; trend, baseline and target data; linkages to K-20 performance measures; and priority projects tied to DOE performance – will be presented to the Board for consideration and adoption. Next steps in the Strategic Planning process will also be reviewed.
