BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Rule 6D-12.002 Campus Security/Police Department establishes guidelines for the Campus Security/Police Department of the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind. These guidelines are adopted by reference in the manual "Campus Security/Police Department Procedures Manual." The amendments to the manual relate to the responsibility of the Police Communications Office to notify the Mental Health Receiving Center that a campus police officer has determined that a student presents an immediate danger to themselves and are being transported to the mental health receiving center. In addition, the manual is amended to require that the Police Communication Office notify the local fire department every time there is a fire alarm on campus rather than after the investigation to determine the validity of the fire alarm.

This rule has been approved and adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind, consistent with authority given to them in Section 1002.36 (4)(c) F.S., at a meeting on December 11, 2004.
