BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Rule 6E-1.0032, Fair Consumer Practices, sets forth the regulations and standards of the Commission for Independent Education relative to fair consumer practices and the operation of independent postsecondary education institutions. This amendment clarifies postsecondary institutions' ability to offer a reduction in tuition or fees when there are specific criteria for student eligibility and selection procedures precisely disclosed within a policy at the institution.

The amendment of the rule has been approved by the Commission of Independent Education at the meeting held on October 12, 2004, following a rules committee meeting October 11, 2004.
