BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Rule 6A-1.0014, FAC., incorporates by reference the DOE Information Data Base Requirements, Volumes I and II, which prescribes the data elements, procedures, and timelines for state reporting, local recordkeeping, and statewide records transfer to be implemented by each school district and the Department. In order to comply with monitoring evaluation components of No Child Left Behind, data elements are added to collect data for Title I Supplemental Educational Services including reading, math, and writing. The Comprehensive Management Information System provides the data on which the measurement of school improvement and accountability is based ensuring that every student has access to the highest quality education.
