Section 1011.62, Florida Statutes

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Section 1011.62(1)(c), Florida Statutes, provides the basis for the annual allocation from the Florida Education Finance Program to each district for operation of schools. Rule 6A-1.09441, FAC, provides the conditions for which a student can generate funding through the Florida Education Finance Program and for which a student may earn credit toward high school graduation. The proposed rule specifies State Board of Education approval for the *Course Code Directory and Instructional Personnel Assignments* for the 2005-2006 school year and is consistent with the Board's direction to provide maximum access to a quality education for all students.

The revised Course Code Directory reflects 2004 legislation and additional courses, which were requested by school districts and recommended for approval by the Department.
