BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Rule 6E-1.0032, F.A.C., Fair Consumer Practices, set forth the criteria of private postsecondary institutions providing a catalog to students and the disclosures required in that catalog.

The amendment clarifies the admissions standards disclosure required in an institution's catalog and adds guidance for institutions regarding special requirements or limitations of students. The amendment of the rule has been approved by the Commission for Independent Education at the meeting held on January 28, 2005.
