BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Rule 6E-2.0042, F.A.C., Medical Clinical Clerkship Programs establishes the criteria for licensure by the Commission for Independent Education of qualified, accredited foreign medical schools to provide clinical clerkship training in Florida hospitals.

The substantial rewrite of this rule expands the medical clinical clerkship approving committee and clarifies the process and criteria foreign medical clinical clerkships programs need for approval. The substantial rewrite of the rule has been approved by the Commission of Independent Education at the meeting held on March 18, 2004, following an international commission workshop held on February 27, 2004.
