BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Rule 6E-2.0061, F.A.C., Actions Against a Licensee; Penalties, describes cease and desist orders issued by the Commission for Independent Education upon a finding of probable cause on a private postsecondary institution. The amendment provides that cease and desist orders also be issued in conjunction with a notice of denial of licensure upon an institution licensed by the commission. The amendment of the rule has been approved by the Commission of Independent Education at the meeting held on January 28, 2005.
