Rule 6E-1.0032(6)(i)6 & 8, Fair Consumer Practices, clarifies nonrefundable fees, clarifies admissions standards, adds guidance for licensees regarding special requirements or limitations of the students and defines a binding contract between the student and institutions licensed by the Commission for Independent Education.

The proposed rule amendment has been approved by the Commission for Independent Education at the meeting held on January 28, 2005.
