- **November 2004-Tampa: Organizational Meeting**
 - Define focus and issues
 - Form Subcommittee workgroups; Assign Chairs
 - Distribute Resource Manuals
 - BOG Strategic Plan Overview

- **February 2005-Tallahassee: Working Meeting**
 - K-20 Strategic Imperative Overview
 - Subcommittee Breakouts

- **April 2005-Orlando: Final Working Meeting**
 - Begin finalizing issues, projects measures/timelines
 - MGT of America Consultant begins to assist w/synthesis
 - Draft due to Council of Presidents for approval, May 2005
