BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On January 18, 2005, the State Board of Education adopted the revised version of the 2004-05 K-20 Strategic Plan. The plan, developed in alignment with the mission of goals of Florida's K-20 education system, identified 8 Strategic Imperatives. Within the 8 imperatives there were 24 objectives, 39 performance measures, and 49 priority projects.

In order to keep State Board members abreast of issues and invite member feedback on the progress of the Strategic Plan, Commissioner Winn has directed that there be an update of at least one Strategic Imperative at each State Board meeting.

For the May meeting, Chancellor David Armstrong, as Imperative leader, will provide a status report on the objectives and performance measures of ***Strategic Imperative 4: Improve the Quality of Instructional Leadership***.

State Board members are encouraged to engage in comments, questions, and feedback related to the status of the Imperative as well as thoughts for future directions.
