SUBJECT: Consideration of Requests for Waivers by Volusia County School Board

PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

To approve the request for waiver of the Volusia County Teacher Assessment System, which states that a tenured teacher must rotate through the Comprehensive Evaluation Cycle every four years.

To approve the request for waiver of Section 1001.452(1)(a), F.S., requiring principal verification that the School Advisory Council is composed of members representing the economic community served by the school.

To approve the request for waiver of Section 1011.62(5), F.S.; Rule 6A-1.0141, which defines categorical funds spent for categorical purposes.

To approve the request for waiver of Section 1008.36, F.S., which places restrictions on how Florida School Recognition funds are used by schools.

To approve the request for waiver of Section 1012.42(2), F.S., requiring written notification to parents regarding teacher out-of-field status.

AUTHORITY FOR STATE BOARD ACTION

Section 1003.62(2), Florida Statutes – Academic Performance Based Charter School Districts.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

In alignment to Florida's Strategic Imperative #3, Improve Student Rates of Learning, the purpose of a waiver request is to maintain or improve high student performance.

On July 11, 2000, the Volusia County School District entered into a contractual agreement with the State Board of Education (Cabinet) to become a charter school district. The contract became effective as of July 1, 2000 through June 30, 2003. On October 8, 2002, the Volusia County Charter District was formally granted approval by the State Board of Education (Cabinet) of their request for a five-year extension on the contract as of July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2008.

The Volusia County Charter District has requested numerous waivers on behalf of individual schools since the inception of the charter district program. The Department of Education received requests for 11 waivers for schools within the district, which are already

addressed in contract language or were deemed a local control issue.

Section 1003.62(2)(a), Florida Statutes, Academic performance-based charter school districts, provides for the exemption of certain State Board of Education rules and statutes for charter districts if, "...the State Board of Education determines such an exemption will assist the district in maintaining or improving its high-performing status..." Additionally, section 1003.62(2)(a)1-9, Florida Statutes, includes a listing of statutes that may not be waived.
