BACKGROUND INFORMATION

These rules are intended to preserve current articulation policies in Florida. Revisions made to these rules are technical in nature. No substantive changes have been made.

These rules have gone through a revision process led by the Articulation Coordinating Committee (ACC). The ACC Standing Committee on Statewide Policies and Guidance (a committee consisting of K-20 education professionals from around the state) discussed proposed revisions to the rules. During this process, input from various constituent groups was solicited and legal counsel was also consulted. In May 2005, the committee approved recommendations for revision. These recommendations were forward to the full ACC for approval. The ACC approved the committee recommendations at its May 25, 2005 meeting. *See attachment for details regarding the specific changes proposed.
