

Rule 6A-10.02412 is amended to read:

6A-10.02412 Foreign Language Competence and Equivalence. The provisions herein shall be used by community colleges and universities to determine equivalency in the university admission requirement in Section 1007.262, ~~240.233(1)~~, Florida Statutes, for two (2) credits in one (1) foreign language at the secondary level or the equivalent at the postsecondary level.

(1) (a)-(b) - No Change.

(2) Eight (8) to ten (10) semester credits in one (1) foreign language at the postsecondary level shall be considered to produce the competence specified in subsection (1) herein. Therefore, students who have earned at least eight (8) semester credits in one (1) foreign language at the postsecondary level shall have met the foreign language requirement for university admission. Credit awarded on the basis of scores on the foreign language subject matter examinations in the College Level Examination Program (CLEP) pursuant to paragraph 6A-10.024(6) (b), F.A.C., shall count toward the eight (8) to ten (10) semester credits. The examination, minimum scores for awarding credit, and minimum ~~maximum~~ credit to be awarded are:
