

Subsections (1) and (5) of Rule 6A-10.041 are amended to read:
6A-10.041 Substitution for Requirements for Eligible Disabled
Students at State Universities, Community Colleges, and
Postsecondary Career Centers ~~Vocational Institutions~~.

(1) Each university and community college board of trustees
~~The Board of Regents, each community college district board of~~
~~trustees,~~ and each district school board which operates a
postsecondary career ~~vocational education~~ center shall develop
and implement policies and procedures for providing reasonable
substitution for eligible students as required by Sections
1007.264, 240.152 and 240.153, Florida Statutes. In determining
whether to grant a substitution, documentation to substantiate
that the disability can be reasonably expected to prevent the
individual from meeting requirements for admission to the
institution, admission to a program of study, entry to upper
division, or graduation shall be provided. For purposes of this
rule, the following definitions shall apply.

(a)-(c) No change.

(2) - (4) No change.

(5) Each public university, community college and
postsecondary career ~~vocational education~~ center operated by a
school district shall maintain records on the number of students
granted substitutions by type of disability, the substitutions
provided, the substitutions identified as available for each

documented disability and the number of requests for
substitutions which were denied.
