BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Section 1011.62(1)(c), Florida Statutes (Funds of operation of schools.--) provides the basis for the annual allocation from the Florida Education Finance Program to each district for operation of schools. Rule 6A-1.09441, FAC, provides the conditions for which a student can generate funding through the Florida Education Finance Program and for which a student may earn credit toward high school graduation. The proposed rule specifies State Board of Education approval for the *Course Code Directory and Instructional Personnel Assignments* for the 2006-2007 school year.

The revised Course Code Directory reflects 2005 legislation and additional courses, which were requested by school districts and reviewed and approved by appropriate Department of Education staff.
