BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Rule 6E-2.001, F.A.C., Approved Applicant Status provides clarity to the criteria and process for institutions seeking "Approved Applicant" licensure status from the Commission for Independent Education and makes the rules a completely reliable point of reference when institutions search for guidelines to obtain "Approved Applicant" licensure status. The current rule is confusing to applicants seeking licensure from the Commission for Independent Education, and this amendment will accurately reflect the licensing procedures.

The amendment of the rule has been approved by the Commission for Independent Education at the meeting held on December 1, 2005, following a Rules Workshop on November 30, 2005.
