SUBJECT: 2005-06 State Board of Education Strategic Plan

PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Approve 2005-06 State Board of Education Strategic Plan.

AUTHORITY FOR STATE BOARD ACTION

Sections 1001.02, 1001.10, and 1008.31, Florida Statutes

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Section 1008.31(3), F.S., establishes the mission of Florida's K-20 education system as: "to increase the proficiency of all students within one seamless, efficient system, by allowing them the opportunity to expand their knowledge and skills through learning opportunities and research valued by students, parents, and communities."

Law requires the State Board of Education to establish and maintain an accountability system that measures student progress toward the following goals:

1. Highest Student Achievement
2. Seamless Articulation and Maximum Access
3. Skilled Workforce and Economic Development
4. Quality Efficient Services

Section 1001.02, F.S., provides that the State Board of Education develop systemwide education goals and policies, including sector and K-20 system strategic plans. Section 1001.10, F.S., specifies that the Commissioner of Education must give full assistance to the State Board in enforcing compliance with the mission and goals of the seamless K-20 education system.

Under the direction of the State Board and new leadership of Commissioner Winn, the 2004-05 Strategic Plan was revised to mark the beginning of a new era of accountability for the K-20 education system with targeted, specific and quantifiable performance measures and expectations. Attached for reference is the final report of the 2004-05 Strategic Plan.

Over the past year some lessons were learned and ideas were generated -- a presentation of a **2005-06 Strategic Plan**, including reference to those "lessons learned" and ideas for consideration, will be provided at the January meeting. The Plan will include updated objectives and performance measures; trend, baseline and target data; linkages to K-20 performance measures; and priority projects tied to DOE performance. Next steps in the process will also be reviewed.
