Career Academy Models and Themes

MODELS/TYPES:

- **"School-Within-A-School"** - A Career Academy within a larger comprehensive high school with a career focus. **There are 20 of this type funded.**
- **"Smaller Learning Communities"** within a comprehensive high school. In many large high schools, the entire school is structured around a Career Academy. Every student in the school is in an Academy. **There are 6 of this type funded.**
- **"Technical High School Magnet Academies"** - Academy program offerings prepare students for postsecondary opportunities as well as "the world of work" with marketable skills. Upon high school graduation, each student receives a high school diploma as well as a certificate of proficiency in a specialized area of study. **There are 13 of this type funded.**

Expected Outcomes (3 year projections)

- **75% increase** in new teacher certification students (from 2,796 to 4,890)
- **765** new nurses in the workforce, **173** new nursing faculty
- ***More than 10,000 K-12 students*** will be served in SUCCEED, Florida Career Path/Academy programs

SUCCEED, Florida

Outcomes as of December 2005

(Prior to spring semester enrollments)

- **667** new teacher certification students
- **278** new nursing students, **114** new nursing faculty
- **866** new students enrolled in Career Academies
- **17** projects implemented or redesigned in 05-06
- **22** additional projects planned for 06-07

Outcomes To Date – Teaching (Community College Students)

- ***557 new teaching students***

Progress Made

- Various recruitment activities
- Marketing efforts
- Planning course offerings and scheduling

Major Successes

- Strong public response to marketing efforts
- Orientation sessions
- Collaborations with school districts to facilitate faster graduation

- ***110 new teaching students***

- Various recruitment and marketing activities
- Rural and urban involvement through use of distance learning

Major Successes

- Creation of online courses for educational minor

Outcomes To Date – Nursing

(Associate and Technical Center Students)

- ***85 new nursing students, 7 new faculty students***

Progress Made

- Recruitment efforts through marketing
- Increase the size of two labs at one college
- Inservice training scheduled for 2006
- Faculty and staff hired

Major Successes

- Project coordinator, lab instructor, and nursing instructor hired in December

Outcomes To Date – Nursing

(Undergraduate and Graduate Students)

- ***193 new nursing students, 107 new faculty students***

Progress Made

- Recruitment and marketing enhanced
- Disseminated information to the field
- Information sessions held throughout state
- Equipment and lab space made available

Major Successes

- Increase in recruitment and enrollment of qualified students
- Partnerships and collaborations with community colleges enhanced
